ABOUT THE QUEBEC-ACADIE RESIDENCIES

The Quebec-Acadia Residencies will enable fifteen artists to create and present their work from Montreal to Cap-Pelé, via Matapedia and Moncton, between August 2024 and June 2027. La Gare de Matapedia - Pôle artistique et communautaire has joined forces with Fonderie Darling (Montreal), Galerie Sans Nom (Moncton) and

Projet Borgitte (Cap-Pelé) to launch this unique initiative. This three-year exchange program aims to strengthen ties between Canada's French-speaking communities, while showcasing Acadian culture. It also aims to bring the Quebec and New Brunswick arts scenes closer together through collaboration between artist-run centers and residencies.

ABOUT INTERNATIONAL RESIDENCIES

Organised in collaboration with the Fonderie Darling, the *International Residencies* enable foreign artists to enjoy a stay in the Montreal metropolis before being invited to discover the magnificent Gaspésie region. In this way, the international residents enjoy both an urban and rural experience of Quebec, moving from a rhythm of sustained cultural events to a period of contemplation and introspection.

ABOUT TRANSATLANTIQUE RESIDENCIES

Organised in collaboration with Montpellier's fine art schools, Toulouse's Institut d'art et de design and Montreal's Darling Foundry, *TransAtlantique Residencies* give young French artists the opportunity to spend time in the metropolis of Montreal, before being invited to discover the magnificent Gaspésie region. In this way, the residents enjoy both an urban and rural experience of Quebec, moving from a rhythm of sustained cultural events to a period of contemplation and introspection.

ABOUT LA GARE DE MATAPÉDIA

La Gare de Matapédia - Pôle artistique et communautaire is both a new space dedicated to contemporary art and a meeting place for the community. Developed by the Quartier Éphémère organization, it offers residencies program, exhibition spaces and cultural mediation activities for schools, community groups and citizens. A variety of activities are regularly scheduled, including meetings with artists, art workshops and guided tours.
